Her priorities contin e to be ele ating the st dent e perience, increasing access and retention initiati es, and pro iding st dents ith the tools, g idance, and reso roes the need to thri e in p rs it of their academic goals. She has a clear strategic ision for ho to lead the College, an normal abilit to nif the camp s comm nit, and a keen e e for impro ing the nancial stabilit and s stainabilit of the organi ation.

Dr. Bastecki-Pere is a rst-generation college grad ate. This e perience has ta ght her the transformati e impact a q alit ed cation can ha e on an indi id al's life. She has since committed herself to e panding academic eq it and incl si eness to pro ide others ith a similar life-altering opport nit for economic gro th and social mobilit.

As Chief Academic Of cer, she broadened the Fac It Di ersit Fello s Program and enriched the comm nit ith the energ and creati it that comes ith di erse perspecti es. This ork also led to MCCC's recognition as one of the Most Promising Places to Work

Under Dr. Bastecki-Pere 's presidential leadership, MCCC has earned the prestigio s Achie ing the Dream's Leader College of Distinction designation for its collectie efforts in improing stedento teomes and narro ingeq it gaps and as one of 10 schools selected for the Racial Eq it Leadership Academ. Additionall, Dr. Bastecki-Pere lanched the Challenger Learning Center in Pottston and the College's rst co-ede Sports team and sec red the largest donation of \$3 million to create the Baker Center of E cellence. She contines to focs on stedent ellness belong the rst communit college in the nation to partner ith TalkSpace and Bene ts Data Trest.

Her close ork ith the Montco Famil for 25 ears incl des ser ing as Interim President, Vice President of Academic Affairs and Pro ost (2010-2020), Associate Vice President of Academic Affairs (2006-2010), Dean of Health and Ph sical Ed cation (2000-2006), and Director and Professor of Dental H giene (1996-2003). Before joining MCCC, she as an a ard-inning fac It member and Senior Clinical S per isor at the Uni ersit of Pittsb rgh, School of Dental Medicine for nine ears.

Dr. Bastecki-Pere 's accomplishments e tend be ond the College's camp ses. She ser es as a member of the Penns I ania Commission for Comm nit Colleges Co ncil of Presidents, as ell as the Penns I ania Higher Ed cation Assessment Leaders co ncil. Additionall, she ser es on the boards of directors of MontcoWorks and the Collegiate Consorti m for Workforce & Economic De elopment, and she ser ed as the Middle States Commission on Higher Ed cation Accreditation Liaison Of cer.

Dr. Bastecki-Pere holds a CDA (1985) and RDH (1986) from the Uni ersit of Pittsb rgh, Dental Assisting and Oral H giene, and a B.S. (1987) in Ed cation from Edinboro Uni ersit of Penns I ania. She began her grad ate co rse ork in 1988 at E eter College, O ford Uni ersit thro gh the Edinboro-O ford E perience st d abroad program, before earning an M.Ed. (1990) and an Ed.D. (1995) in Instructional Design and Technolog from the Uni ersit of Pittsb rgh. She as recognied as a Disting ished Al mna b Edinboro Uni ersit in 2000 and b the Uni ersit of Pittsb rgh School of Dental Medicine in 2010.

# HISTOR OF THE COLLEGE

Montgomer Co nt Comm nit College started its rst semester on October 3, 1966 ith 17 fac It members, a librar of 500 books, and an enrollment of 428 st dents in the former Conshohocken High School. Toda , the College enrolls more than 18,000 credit st dents ann all , and st dents enjo the e ibilit of learning at the College's camp ses in BI e Bell and Pottsto n, at the C linar Arts Instit te in Lansdale, and online.

Fo nded in 1964, and accredited b the Middle States Commission on Higher Ed cation, the College has gro n ith the comm nit to meet the lifelong learning needs of Montgomer Co nt . The College boasts a nationall recogni ed fac It and a comprehensi e, rigoro s c rric I m that incl des more than 100 associate degree and certi cate programs, as ell as speciali ed orkforce de elopment training and certi cations. The College is pro d of the s ccesses of its more than 78,000 al mni.

As an Achie ing the Dream Leader College of Distinction, Montgomer Co nt Comm nit College is positioned at the ang ard of national efforts to increase completion, impro e learning o tcomes and remo e barriers to access for all st dents. For the si th consec ti e ear, the College as named one of the Most Promising Places to Work in Comm nit Colleges in the nation for its ork to enhance eq it, di ersit, and incl sion. The College also is recogni ed regionall and nationall for its inno ati e technolog, s stainabilit leadership, ork ith militar eterans, and comm nit ser ice and ser ice learning opport nities.

T e P e de a Meda , orn b Montgomer Co nt Comm nit College's president, is imprinted ith the College seal on the front and the president's name on the back. Each side of the chain has three identical ornamental components: the Lamp of Learning, hich represents higher ed cation and the contin o s search for isdom and kno ledge; the Tree of Life, hich represents personal de elopment and gro thas an instit tion forged thro ghor niq e and di erse perspecti es; and the Hands, hich represents o r contin ed commitment to partnerships and b ilding comm nit to dri e s ccess for st dents at the College and be ond. Bet een each s mbol is a red gem, hich represents one of the College's primar school colors and the importance of keeping the ision, mission, and al es as a central e li e and embod the al es of the College in o r foc s of ho

dail li es.
