 - d. Accidentals
 - e. FGAB materials in both hands
 - f. Solo and ensemble repertoire for reading and accompanying
3. Topic 2 (3-4 weeks)
 - a. Major pentachord and triads
 - b. Eighth note material
 - c. Triad work
