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- f Applicants must successfully complete at least one year of
biology and chemistry or the college equivalent, within the past 10 years prior to enrolling in
SUR 105. [Applicants without high school biology and/or chemistry can satisfy this
requirement by completing the College's BIO 121 or CHE 121 courses].
- f Applicants must submit official college transcript(s) for credit evaluation, if applicable, no
later than March 1st of SUR 105 enrollment year.
- f Applicants must complete the College placement tests in English, Mathematics, and Reading
and place above the developmental level.
- f Applicants must successfully complete % , 2 RU WUDQVIHU IDJXDREI'Q&H QrW ZL
better within 5 years, as a pre-requisite course for enrollment in SUR 105.
- f Applicants must successfully complete ENG 101 as a pre-requisite for enrollment in SUR
105.
